



## Physician Update

### **Epic issues resolved**

(Information updated as of Jan. 24)

Through engagement with physicians and physician leaders, issues are being identified, prioritized and resolved on an ongoing basis. Recently resolved issues include:

- Scrub techs can now to be added directly to the C-section portion of the delivery summary
- A column displaying the admission diagnosis to clinicians was added to the patient list
- Heparin Induced Thrombocytopenia Alert will now display when orders for heparin or LMWH are ordered, verified or administered on patients who have abnormal lab results for HEPARINPF4, PF4IGG REACTIVITY
- Hard stop has been added back to the PEDS general admission order set – physicians will need to choose a location for a PEDS admission
- The Blood Transfusion Record was implemented after going through a review process and being approved by the Change Control Board – this report will provide a single source of information related to blood transfusion for a specific patient and is located in the Patient Summary Index under “Additional Reports”
